

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

June 11, 2021

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

It is with much joy and thanksgiving that I am writing to invite you to come home to the indoor worship service beginning June 20, 2021 which also happens to be on Father's Day!

After ten months of outdoor worship, we are ready to restart our indoor service. Governor Newsom is expected to make a public announcement on June 15th to lift all restrictions for COVID-19 except masking. The updated guidelines will allow us to sing indoor as long as masks are worn. The practices of registration, temperature checking and physical distancing will no longer be required. Cars will be allowed to park next to each other in the parking lot without an empty space to separate them.

As we begin the indoor worship, we will implement practices to help us easily transition back to our indoor venue. There will be hand sanitizing stations provided at strategic locations, our pastors will preach from behind Plexiglas barriers, and the worship team will lead us in praising God with their masks (disposable) on. Our AC system has been upgraded with CDC recommended air filters and the doors in the MAC will be opened for better air circulation.

Families with young children may attend service in one of the following ways: sit in the MAC for indoor worship, watch livestreaming on TV screen in the courtyard and breezeway, or stay inside their cars to connect through Zoom. To protect those younger than 12 years old who are unvaccinated, we will request all those who attend indoor service to put on their masks even if it is lifted on June 20. Online worship will still be available for those who join us from their respective home through livestreaming or recording. Other practices will be considered as we monitor the progress of the indoor worship.

We will begin with the adult worship on June 20th and the children and youth ministry will follow once we are more settled in meeting indoors. Please understand that our protocols may change according to the latest guidelines from the LA County. We will do our best to follow our reopening guidelines of legality, safety, sustainability and glorifying God. Please pray for us as we continue to discern God's guidance as He calls us to regather.
